Broadwater Public School Project update | March 2024



Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is committed to rebuilding flood affected schools in the Northern Rivers region, ensuring we build back better with flood resilient schools for local students and local communities. Funding for the school projects has also been provided by the Infrastructure Betterment Fund, which is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments through the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

Project overview

As part of this commitment, a project is underway to rebuild Broadwater Public School, after it was extensively damaged during floods in early 2022. The project will deliver a flood resilient school, with new classrooms, library, canteen and administration areas, and landscaping.

Move in date confirmed

We are excited to confirm that work on this important project is nearly finished and the first day back at the rebuilt Broadwater Public School will be **Monday, 31 March 2025**.

Despite the heavy rain and wind that came with ex-Tropical Cyclone Alfred, work at the site was able to resume quickly and the project remains on track for completion as planned.

Over the next few weeks, the team will be putting the finishing touches on the landscaping, relocating school resources and working with school staff to get everything ready to welcome students on Day 1.

Travelling to and from school

We have been working with Transport for NSW to make sure bus routes are changed back from Evans River Community School to Broadwater Public School in time for the move. Parking and pedestrian access arrangements at the school will be the same as they were before the rebuild. The main entry for the school remains via the cul de sac in Byrnes Street. On Day 1 staff will assist any families who aren't familiar with the school site and accompany students to their new classrooms.
