### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

### Investing in our schools

A project is underway to upgrade Brooke Avenue Public School to replace four demountable classrooms. The project will deliver:

- A new permanent building which will provide four innovative and flexible learning spaces, two withdrawal rooms and a practical activity area. All rooms will be air conditioned.
- New sports court area.

The new building will be constructed on the existing sports court area.

### Progress summary

The project has received approval to proceed. Concept designs of the new building have been finished.

An architect and project consultants have been appointed to investigate and review the site and further develop the designs.

The main works construction contract has been awarded to North Construction & Building Pty Ltd.

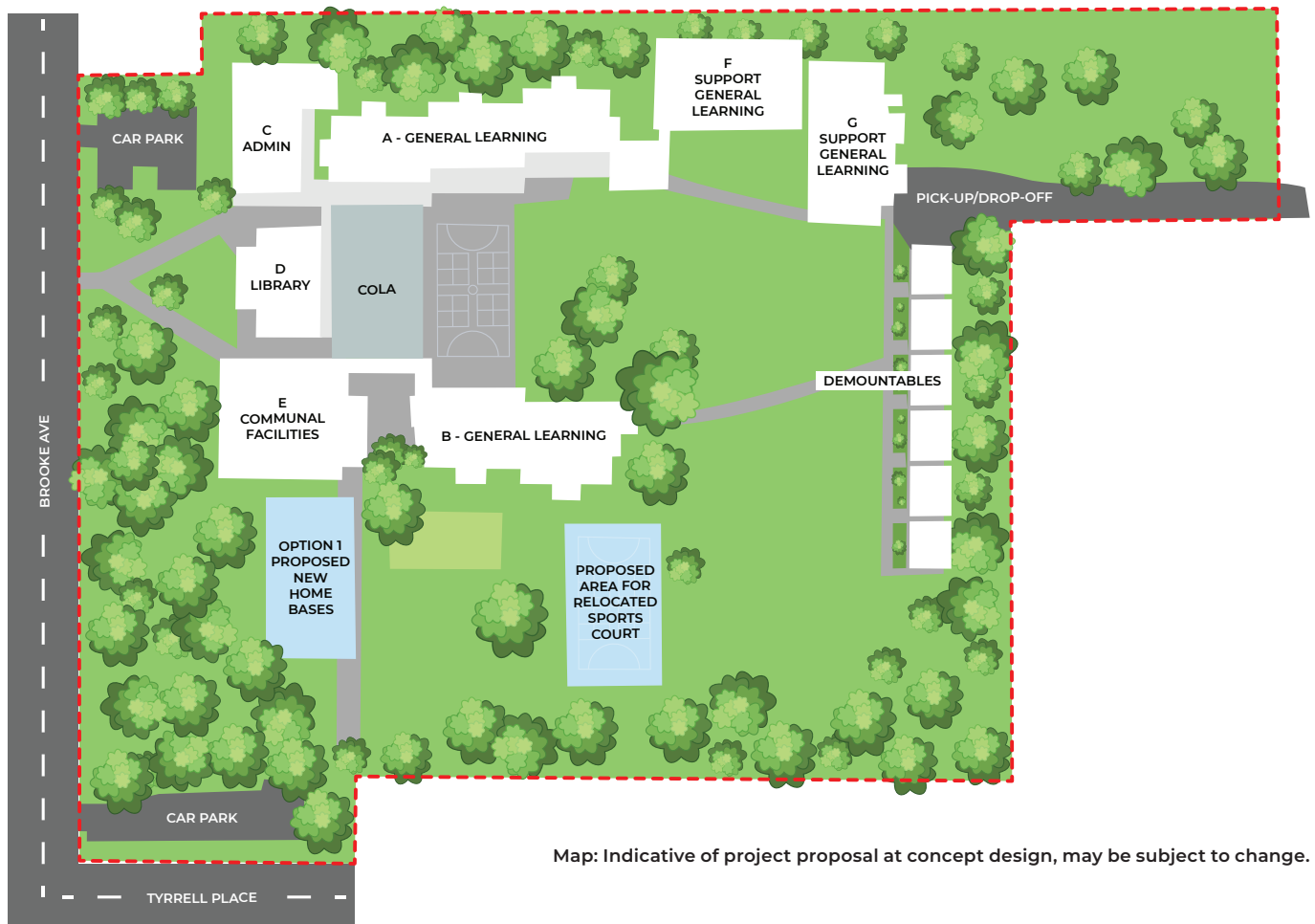
### Next steps

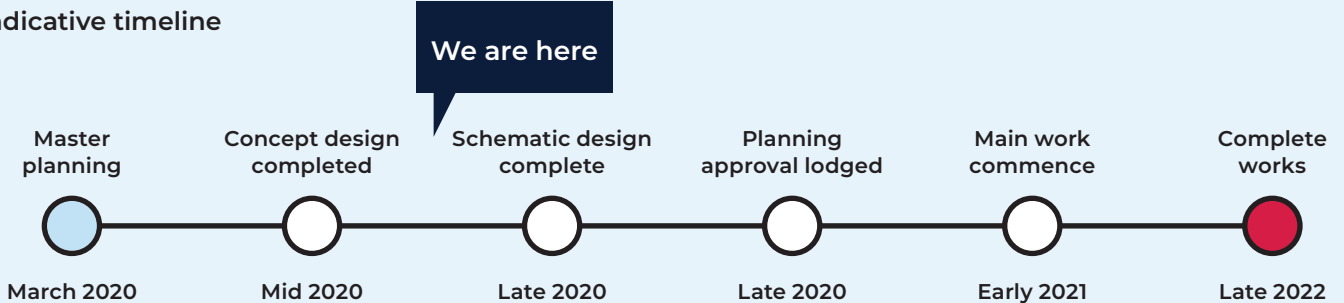
