Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Brookvale Public School

A project is underway at Brookvale Public School. The project will deliver:

- a new hall
- two refurbished learning spaces; and
- improved outdoor play spaces.

Progress summary

A development application has been approved by Northern Beaches Council and a tender for construction has been awarded to Lloyd Group with works to start in January 2020.

Site establishment and works commencement

Site establishment prepares the construction area so that construction work can begin. This will include;

installing the site office and work sheds

- delivering equipment to the site, and
- demolition of an old toilet block.

Summer school holiday works

Works will start from 6 January 2020 and take place Monday to Friday between 7:00am and 5:00pm and on Saturdays between 8:00am and 1:00pm. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

During construction, traffic management and measures to mitigate noise and dust will be implemented to ensure the safety of the school community and neighbours.

School Infrastructure NSW will work closely with the school community and neighbours to minimise impacts where possible.

We will ensure that the school and local community are provided with regular project updates.

Frequently asked questions

What works will be completed over the holidays?

The construction area will be established so that construction work can be begin. This will include the establishment of a site office and work sheds, a small amount of demolition, and deliveries to the site.

What are the construction working hours?

Construction hours over the summer school holidays will be:

- Monday to Friday from 7:00am to 5:00pm
- Saturday from 7:00am to 1:00pm.

No work will take place on Sundays and public holidays.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

No works will start until 6 January 2020.

What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Temporary fencing will be erected around the construction site to secure the area.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Noise and dust control measures will be implemented in accordance with planning approval requirements.

Hoarding and shade cloth will be erected to reduce noise and dust impacts on the school and local residents. Dust from construction works will be hosed down as required.

How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, the local community and workers.

Traffic controllers will be used where required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.
