Investing in schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Brookvale Public School upgrade

A project is underway at Brookvale Public School to deliver a new hall, refurbish two learning spaces and provide improved outdoor play spaces.

Progress Summary

The project team have been appointed and working with the Principal to inform the design and positioning of the new hall to ensure the upgrade meets the future needs of the school and the broader community.

Next steps

The design of the school upgrade is being finalised. A development application will be submitted to local council in late April 2019. The development application includes the demolition of the unused toilets in the north corner of the school and removal of three trees to accommodate where the new hall will be built. Additional trees will be planted to maintain the tree provision at the school.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.
