Investing in schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Brookvale Public School upgrade

A project is underway at Brookvale Public School. The project will deliver:

- a new hall
- two refurbished learning spaces; and
- improved outdoor play spaces

Progress Summary

The project team has been appointed and is working with the Principal to inform the design and positioning of the new hall. The siting of the hall will ensure the upgrade meets the future needs of the school and the broader community.

Development Application

A development application was submitted to local council in April and is on exhibition. The development application includes the demolition of the unused toilets in the north corner of the school and removal of three trees to accommodate where the new hall will be built. Additional trees will be planted to maintain the tree provision at the school.
