# Project update

#### **Progress summary**

The new School hall and improved outdoor play space have been completed. These were handed over the the school on 7 August 2020 and are now being enjoyed by students and teachers.

### Next steps

Work continues on refurbishing the old hall into two learning spaces. The old awning and timber deck have been demolished, with work now underway on footings for the new awning. Work is also taking place on the ceiling and flooring of the old hall.

All works will be completed within the approved hours of Monday to Friday 7:00am to 5:00pm and Saturday 8:00am to 3:00pm.
