

# Budawang School relocation

Works notification | 18 July 2023

A project is underway to relocate the existing Budawang School in Ulladulla to a new facility in Milton. The project will deliver additional purpose-built learning spaces and a hydrotherapy aquatic facility to cater to students with disability from years K-12. There will be seven new learning spaces to accommodate student growth and new core facilities.

## Power outage due to electrical work taking place between 7am – 5pm on 26 July 2023

On Wednesday 26 July 2023 electrical work being undertaken at the Budawang School relocation site will result in a power outage to some neighbouring properties between 7am and 5pm.

The work will involve replacing two power poles and installing a new substation to provide important electrical infrastructure for the relocation of the existing Budawang School.

The following day, Thursday 27 July 2023, the redundant aerials and poles supplying electricity to the existing school will be removed. This work will not disrupt power supply to neighbouring properties.
