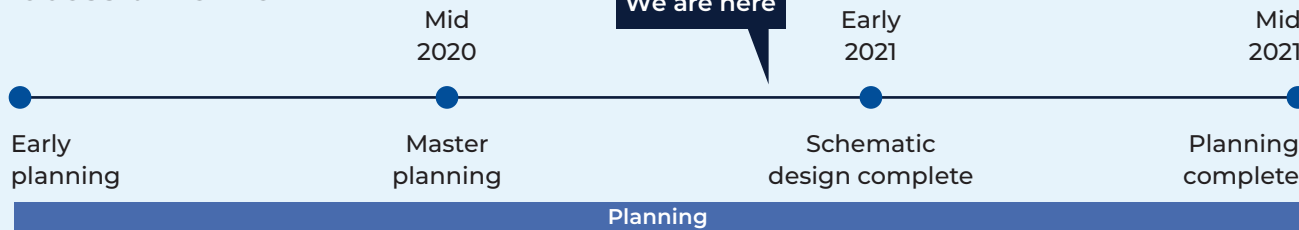

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver more than 200 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

The project comprises the relocation of the existing Budawang School for Specific Purposes (SSP) in Ulladulla to a dedicated and fit for purpose facility at the recently acquired site in Milton NSW.

This new location is on the former Shoalhaven Anglican School site. The project will deliver new purpose built learning spaces for the Budawang School to cater for students with moderate (IO) or severe intellectual disabilities (IS) from years K – 12.

The project will deliver:

- 7 classrooms to accommodate student growth and improve existing facilities
- administration block
- Covered outdoor learning area (COLA)
- school hall/multipurpose area
- carpark
- hydrotherapy pool
- external works
- soft and hard landscaping.

Progress summary

The project has completed the initial planning phase, including development of the Concept Design, which has been developed following consultation with school representatives and the local disability sector.

Next steps include the development of the Schematic Design as well as progression of the statutory planning pathway.

The project has requested the Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements (SEARs), and the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) has assessed the project and advised the studies that need to be included as part of the State Significant Development Application (SSDA) leading to additional stakeholder consultation.

After the SSDA is lodged with DPIE, the project will be placed on public exhibition, allowing the community and other stakeholders to make comments. We expect this will be later in 2021. Once the development application has been approved, construction work can start.

The project will have community engagement opportunities moving forward, including engagement with the local Aboriginal community, consultation with the existing Budawang School and local authorities.
