### Traffic changes on Majara Street and Gibraltar Street

The new Bungendore High School is opening on Day 1 Term 1 2023 at its temporary site on Bungendore Public School. To ensure the safety of students, staff, parents/carers and the community, traffic upgrades are being made and will be in effect from Tuesday 31 January 2023.

The traffic changes are being made in consultation with Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council.

#### Gibraltar Street

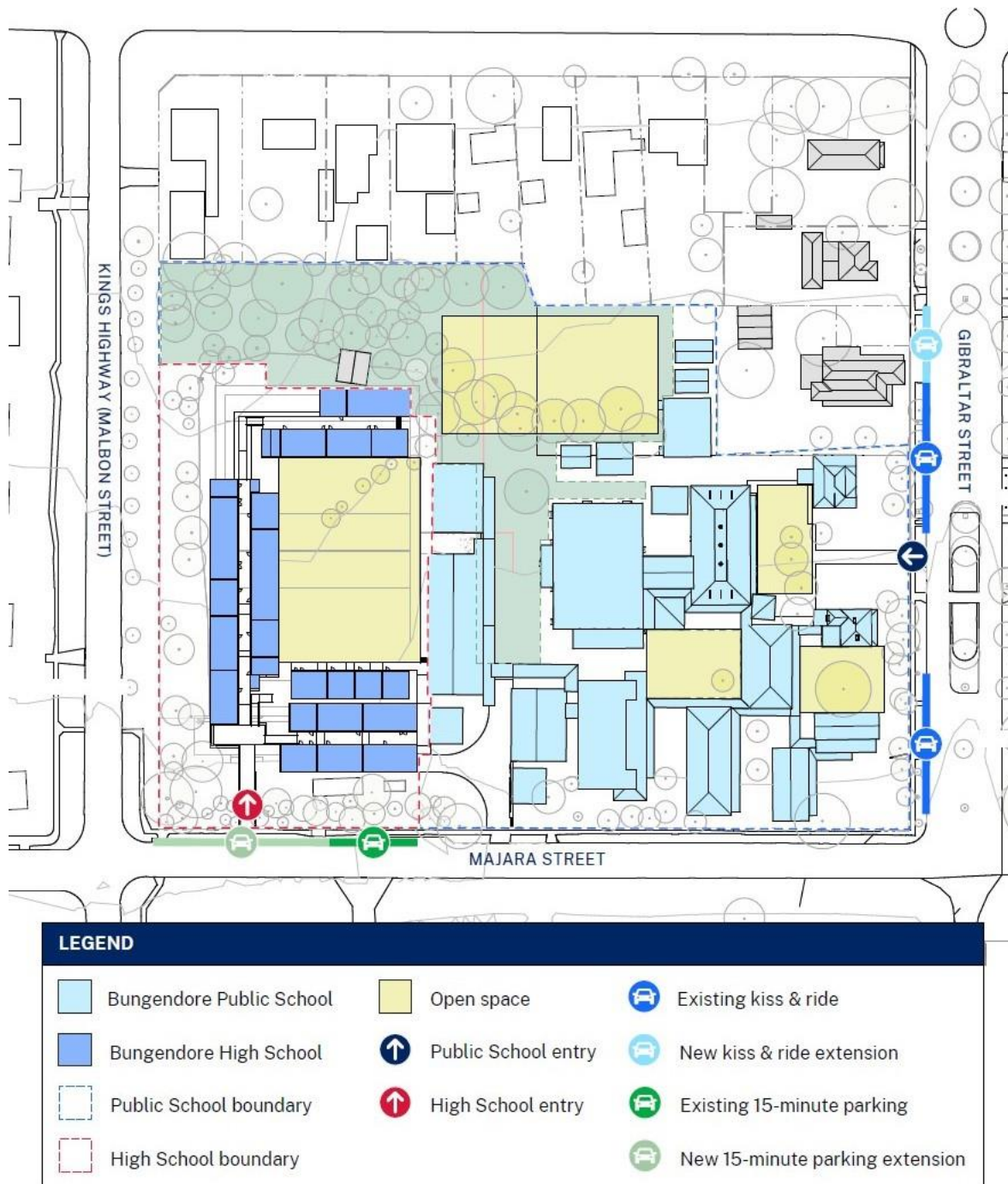


Figure 1: map showing changes to traffic conditions in Gibraltar Street and Majara Street (indicative only).

In Gibraltar Street, the existing kiss and ride area will be extended (see Figure 1), and the existing kiss and ride restrictions signage will be replaced.

The new signs will align with those of the existing kiss and ride area on the eastern side of the crossing on Gibraltar Street, for consistency.

The blue kiss and ride line marking on the kerb will also be refreshed.

#### Majara Street

In Majara Street, the existing short stay parking area, near to the intersection with Kings Highway, has been extended (see also Figure 1).

#### Traffic controllers

Two traffic controllers will be in place for the first four days of school (from 31 January – 3 February 2023) to assist parents/carers in the correct use of the traffic management measures. The traffic controllers will be in place for half an hour prior to and after the school 40km speed zone times.
