Works notification | 22 April 2024

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to deliver a new permanent high school at Bungendore to accommodate 450 students.

## Temporary changes to fencing for Anzac Day 2024

Temporary changes will be made to the existing site perimeter fence to accommodate pedestrian access from the Bungendore War Memorial to the Bungendore Scout Hall for Anzac Day.

This will enable pedestrian use of part of the footpath within the site boundary and the northern section of Majara Street between the pool and Turallo Terrace on the morning of 25 April 2024 only.

## Temporary changes to site perimeter fence to Mick Sherd Oval

Additionally, temporary changes will also be made to the site perimeter fencing near Mick Sherd Oval to enable use of the existing footpath on the eastern side of the oval.

This temporary change will be in place until works commence on the new school.

When works start, the fence boundary will return to its current location and the footpath will be permanently closed.

The department will provide further information about when the footpath will close when the construction program has been confirmed.




Figure 1 – temporary location of the site perimeter fence until works start on the new high school.
