Short term power arrangement for temporary school site

As notified on 16 December, the electrical substation powering Bungendore Public School will soon be upgraded to cater for the temporary school and future improvements of the public school. This upgrade work will take place in early 2023, subject to design work and associated approvals.

To ensure power supply meets the requirements of the temporary high school, a temporary generator will be installed on the public school grounds as a supplementary measure. The generator will now be installed the week of **9 January**, not on 22 and 23 December 2022 as previously notified.

Use of the generator will be limited to 7am to 6pm weekdays. This is a temporary measure and the generator won't be needed for all of the temporary school's power supply, and will be removed when the upgrade to the substation is completed.

School Infrastructure NSW has engaged an acoustic consultant to design the acoustic enclosure that will be built so that the generator complies with the NSW Environment Protection Authority criteria.

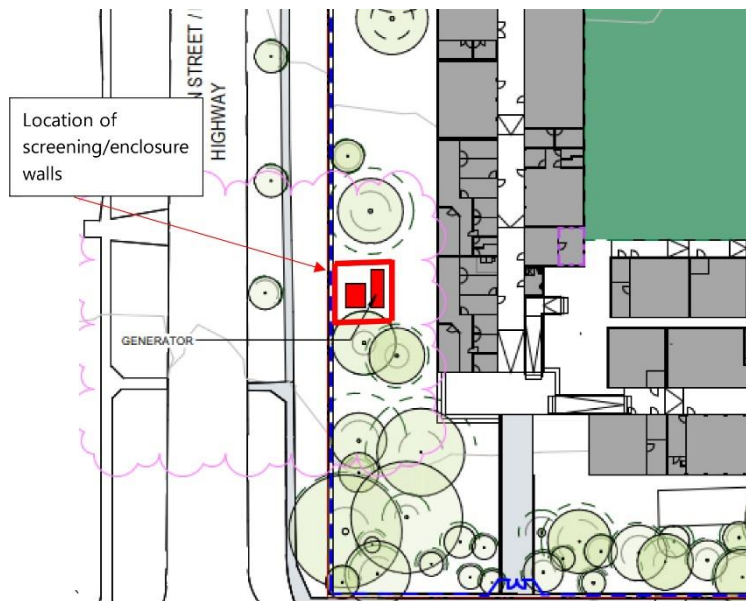


Figure 1: indicative location of the temporary generator.

The generator is exempt from requiring planning approvals, however, a Review of Environmental Factors will be undertaken as due diligence.
