Progress summary

Construction commenced in early 2019 with site preparation, bulk earthworks and retaining wall installation. Works are progressing well with the majority of concrete slabs now poured. Ongoing activities will include:

- Relocating in-ground utility services
- Pouring concrete slabs
- Erecting structural steel and roof installation.

The project is forecast for completion mid-2020.
