# **Canley Vale High School**

#### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

### Canley Vale High School

A project is underway to upgrade Canley Vale High School to cater for projected growth in the area. The upgrade will provide new modern facilities containing flexible, future-focused and technology rich teaching spaces to create dynamic learning experiences for students and encourage collaboration. The project will deliver:

- a new building with 16 new permanent learning spaces including a seminar room
- an administration building extension and upgrade
- a school entrance upgrade
- a school hall upgrade and extension
- a new canteen
- a new toilet block

#### **Progress summary**

Demolition and site establishment was undertaken in late 2018. The administration building and school entrance were finished in August 2019.

#### **Next steps**

The upgrade of the school hall was due for completion in late 2019. This will now be early 2020. Construction works and managing the impacts on school operations during HSC exams has meant timeframes have changed.

Construction has progressed on the new learning hub with the ground and first floors laid. The building steel framework will be installed during the summer school holidays. The building is expected to be completed in March / April 2020. The final stage to be delivered will be the new toilet block with the entire project due to finish in mid 2020. The proposed plan for the school is shown overleaf.


