

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Progress summary

A project is underway to upgrade Canley Vale High School, which will provide 16 new flexible learning spaces and upgrades to the staff administration building, hall, school entrance, and a new canteen and toilet block.

Completed works include the new canteen and upgrades to the school administration building and entrance.

Summer school holiday works

Construction in the school hall resumed in November 2019 once HSC exams finished. Remaining works include the stage and internal fit out.

Early works on the new learning hub building are underway and will continue through 2020. The foundation and first floor concrete slab have been laid and during summer school holidays a structural steel framework will be erected, and wall sheeting and first installation of services, such as electrical wiring will be completed.

Construction hours

Construction work will take place Monday to Friday, 7:00am to 6:00pm, and Saturday from 8:00am to 1:00pm. No work will take place on Sundays or Public Holidays. The construction site will shut down from close of business Tuesday, 24 December 2019 and resume on Thursday, 2 January 2020.

Traffic and safety

Traffic control and security measures will be in place where required for the safety of the community.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently, and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.

Frequently asked questions

What works will be completed over the holidays?

Construction will continue over the summer school holidays with final internal works to the school hall and work progressing on the new learning hub building.

What are the construction working hours?

Construction work will take place Monday to Friday, 7:00am to 6:00pm, and Saturday from 8:00am to 1:00pm. No work will take place on Sundays or Public Holidays.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

Site works will stop at close of business Tuesday, 24 December 2019 and resume on Thursday, 2 January 2020.

What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Temporary fencing has been installed around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

In line with the Construction Management Plan, the contractor will continue to implement dust and noise control measures.

Dust and noise will be minimised through the use of hoarding and shade cloth. Dust will be controlled by spraying water during earth works whenever permissible under water-use restrictions.

How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, the local community and workers. Traffic controllers will be deployed to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.
