Project overview

A project is underway to provide a new multi-purpose hall at Canterbury Boys High School. The new hall will include a stage, gymnasium, indoor sports court, female and male amenities, first-aid room and back of house facilities.

Progress summary

The Development Application (DA) has been approved by the Inner West Council and the detailed design is being finalised.

Main construction works are anticipated to start from Friday 11 November 2022.

Construction vehicles will access the site via the secondary student parking gate off Hardy Street, which will be unavailable for use by the school throughout the works.
