The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Planning for a new hall at Canterbury Boys High School

We are currently undertaking planning for a new hall at Canterbury Boys High School. This planning includes development of a schematic design, which is expected to be shared with the community later this year.

This exciting project aims to bring students the latest facilities and will include a stage, indoor sports court, storage, toilets, and back of house facilities.

The upgrade of Canterbury Boys High School Hall is being fast-tracked as part of the NSW Government's \$3 billion Jobs and Infrastructure Acceleration fund.

Progress summary

The NSW Government approved funding in late 2020 to plan and deliver the new hall.

Planning has started to understand the requirements for the project. Early planning typically involves the development of a business case and design, and site investigations. Detailed site investigations will form part of the project, which may include drilling for borehole samples.

Schematic design and the tender process to construct the new hall is expected to start late this year. We expect construction to start in early 2022 with the aim of completing the hall in late 2022 (subject to planning approvals).

How can I get involved?

We are committed to working together with our school communities and other stakeholders to deliver the best possible learning facilities for students.

The project team are working closely with representatives of Canterbury Boys High School, as part of the Project Reference Group (PRG). This group will meet regularly to review design options and monitor progress of the project.
