Getting to school

School entrances and pedestrian routes

The main school entrance is located on France Street. Pedestrians can also access the school using entrances on High Street and Napier Street.

New 'kiss and drop' area

The kiss and drop area can be accessed via the school's new internal link road between France Street and Napier Street.

The road is a one-way street with a speed limit of 5kmph. Cars must enter from Napier Street and exit via France Street.

The road will be open for drop off from 8:50 am to 9:30 am and pick up from 3 pm to 3:30 pm. There will be no access at other times of day and no parking on the road.
