Project update

Canterbury South Public School is being developed to deliver new and upgraded facilities, innovative learning spaces, and provide for growing student enrolments in the area. In mid 2019, demountable classrooms were installed. Stage 1 construction works are about to start.

Next Steps

In December 2019 or early 2020 a demountable building will be installed for school administration and staff. Site establishment works will start with safety construction fencing erected, a site office and work sheds installed, building equipment delivered and demolition works undertaken. In early 2020 construction is expected to commence on the main works, subject to Council approval of a Development Application (DA), and is expected to continue until mid 2021.

Site establishment

During site establishment and construction all steps will be taken to ensure the safety of the school and residential community and minimise the impacts of construction. Construction works will take place from 7.00am to 5.30pm Monday to Friday and 7.00am to 1.00pm Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

In the finished project it is intended to retain staff car parking however some spaces may be lost during construction to accommodate the administration demountable building. We will work closely with the site manager and school operations to provide as much notice as possible when changes occur.

School Infrastructure will work closely with the school community and neighbours to minimise impacts where possible and ensure continuity of school operations. Notifications to the school community and surrounding neighbours will be issued prior to any work being undertaken.
