Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Canterbury South Public School

The upgrade at Canterbury South Public School will deliver:

- a new building with 30 teaching spaces
- a new administration building
- a new library
- a new hall
- a new canteen
- a Covered Outdoor Learning Area (COLA)
- upgraded landscaping.

Project summary

Stage I works are progressing well with a number of existing buildings demolished to prepare for future construction of the new building (see overleaf).

A retaining wall on High Street has been constructed to maintain an easement to the newly installed substation.

A Development Application (DA) was lodged for stage 2 main works. A second traffic report was prepared and submitted to assist in progressing the DA approval with Canterbury-Bankstown Council.

A demountable building, nearest to the corner of High Street and France Street on the site, was installed in April 2020 for school administration.

Next steps

On Monday 11 May 2020, the school administration will relocate from its existing location into the demountable building. The entrance to the new administration building and school office will be via the France Street gate.


Safety fencing with shadecloth will be erected to section off the old administration building so that it can be demolished.

Other construction works in progress include the installation of new utility services such as power, water and communications, and site preparation in order to start main works
