Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Proposed bus stop consolidation

Canterbury South Public School is being developed to deliver new and upgraded facilities, innovative learning spaces, and provide for growing student enrolments in the area.

As part of the upgrade project, City of Canterbury Bankstown Council have requested School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) investigate how bus access to the school could be improved by consulting the community.

SINSW have worked with Transport for NSW and the bus operator to develop proposed changes to bus access on Fore Street to benefit the school community and local bus customers. The following bus stop changes are proposed:

- Relocating bus stop ID 219392 by 125m to the east. The bus stop will meet access requirements from the Disability Discrimination Act (DDA).
- Relocating bus stop ID 219391 by 75m to the east. The bus stop will meet access requirements from the DDA.
- Removal of stop ID 219393.

This bus stop consolidation is intended to improve the reliability of bus route and improve journey times between Hurstville and Five Dock via Canterbury Station.

The stops will be located closer High Street, reducing the time for teachers and parents to access Canterbury South Public School by 75m and 125m.
