

Canterbury South Public School

Works notification

7 February 2022

A project is underway to upgrade Canterbury South Public School and provide new and improved education facilities to support the student community.

As previously notified in works notifications dated 15 April 2021 and 28 October 2021, the project includes upgrades to the public domain as part of the planning approval conditions for the upgrade project. The works will improve pedestrian safety and encourage active travel to and from Canterbury South Public School.

The public domain works will take place from Monday 14 February to Saturday 5 March 2022, weather permitting. In the event of wet weather, works may be postponed.

The public domain works include:

- removing and replacing existing pedestrian islands and kerb ramps at:
 - Potter Avenue west of Woolcott Street
 - Barnes Avenue west of Woolcott Street
 - Fuller Avenue west of Woolcott Street.

Traffic controllers will be in place on Potter Avenue, Barnes Avenue and Fuller Avenue during the works to manage traffic flow and pedestrian safety.

Working hours

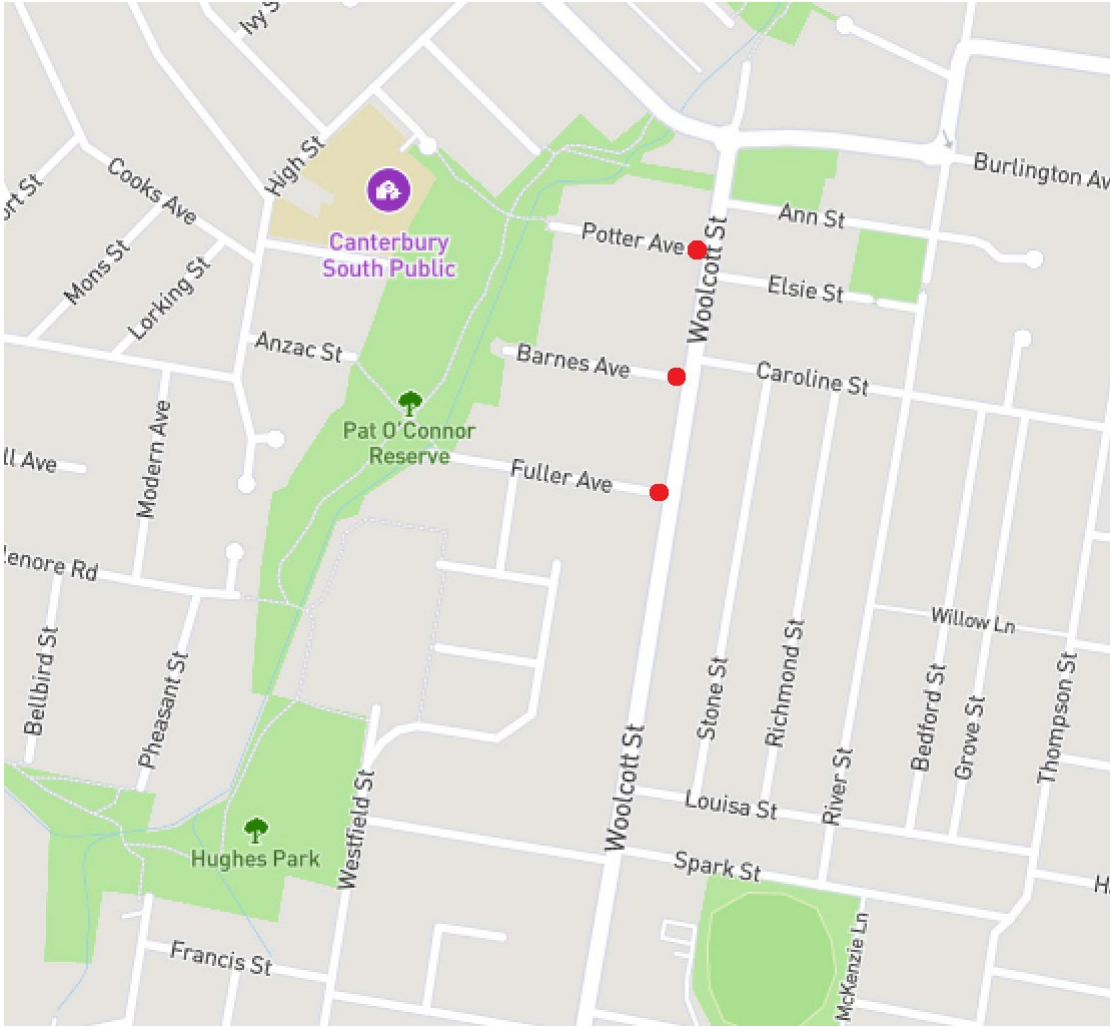
The standard construction hours for this project are 7 am to 5 pm Monday to Saturday. No work will take place on Sunday or public holidays, unless otherwise notified.
