Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver more than 200 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

The redevelopment at Canterbury South Public School will deliver:

- a new building with 30 teaching spaces
- a new administration building
- a new library
- a new hall and new canteen
- covered outdoor learning area (COLA)
- upgraded landscaping.

Progress summary

Staff from School Infrastructure NSW recently completed a door knock in the area to provide information to local residents around the planned public domain works.

The public domain works are designed to make accessibility to the school an easier and safer walk for students and parents. They include footpath and kerb work and additional pedestrian islands to make streets easier to cross. More details can be found on the SINSW school projects webpage.

Construction of Block 1 (formerly referred to as Block A) is progressing well with the foundations set, work has started on level one and the roof. Block 1 will accommodate the new administration facilities, library, canteen, and special programs rooms.

Block 2 (formerly Block B) will accommodate the new hall and covered outdoor learning area, construction is also well underway and taking shape.

The retaining wall for the new internal road has been completed. Earthworks have started in preparation of the new Block 3 (formerly Block C) building.

Required tree pruning has occurred with an arborist on site to consult and advise.

Next steps

Façade work will continue to take place for Block 1 and 2. This will include details on the outside of the building, like the window frames, cladding and required balustrades, handrails and screens. In addition, work will continue on the process of fitting out the services required to operate the buildings.

Concrete pours will occur in June for Block 3, to set up the building foundations.
