

# Canterbury South Public School

## Works notification

20 May 2021

We are upgrading Canterbury South Public School with new and improved education facilities to support the student community.

As part of the upgrade, continued works to remediate and encapsulate asbestos containing material are required. As identified on the school's Asbestos Management Plan, the material is bonded asbestos, which means it is attached to other material such as cement or vinyl and cannot be crumbled by light pressure.

This material is located within the current construction area, outside of the operational school. The construction area is cordoned off and is out of bounds and inaccessible to students and staff.

The area will be managed in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and SafeWork NSW regulations. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The material is scheduled to be remediated on Saturdays from 22 May 2021 to 10 July 2021 between 7:00am and 5:00pm. All asbestos containing material will be remediated outside of school hours.

Testing will be completed to ensure the area has been fully remediated and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is open to students and staff. We will keep you informed if further material is found which requires removal.

The health, safety, and well-being of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Please be assured that the removal of this material will not pose a risk to the local community.
