

Canterbury South Public School

Works notification

28 October 2021

A project is underway to upgrade Canterbury South Public School. The project includes upgrades to the public domain as part of the planning approval conditions for the upgrade project.

The following works will be undertaken by School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) to improve pedestrian safety and encourage active travel to and from Canterbury South Public School.

The public domain works include:

- Re-construction of existing island and installation of kerb ramps at:
 - Howard Street west of High Street
 - Cooks Avenue west of High Street
- Installation of kerb ramps at:
 - Potter Avenue west of Woolcott Street
 - Barnes Avenue west of Woolcott Street
 - Fuller Avenue west of Woolcott Street
 - Canton Street West of High Street

To comply with current Australian Standards and Transport for NSW (TfNSW) Technical Guidelines, it is necessary to install No Stopping restrictions at the proposed pedestrian refuge islands. This will result in the removal of two on-street parking spaces on the western side of Howard Street.

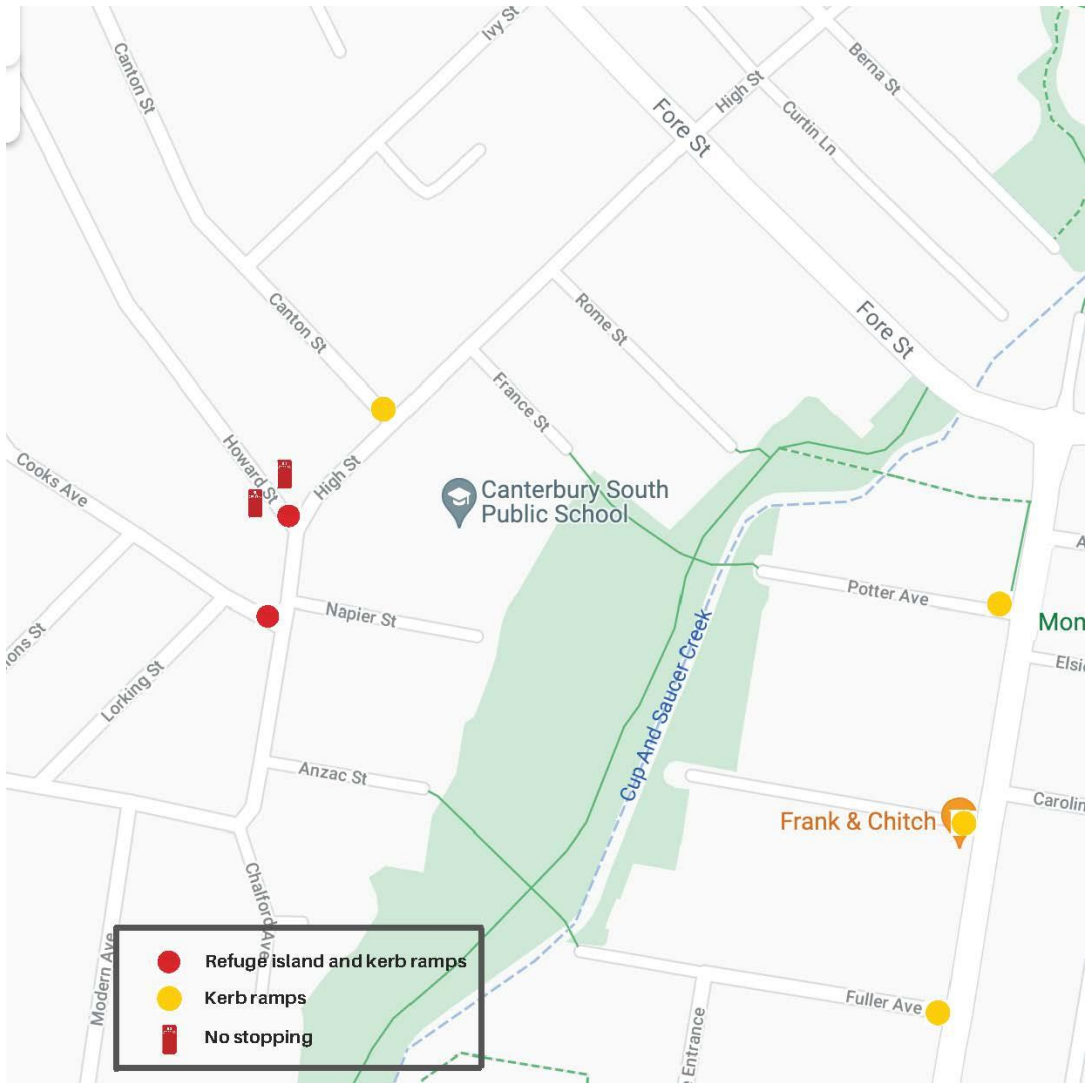
