Dear Neighbour,

We are upgrading Canterbury South Public School with new and improved education facilities for students. We are writing to provide an update on the stormwater connection works as this project continues.

Stormwater connection works

We will be carrying out council approved works to connect a stormwater pipe into the existing stormwater line. The works will take place in Pat O'Connor Reserve immediately adjacent to the Canterbury South Public School upgrade site from Wednesday, 29 September 2021.

These works are expected to take approximately one week to complete.

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Temporary fencing will be installed around the construction site and into Pat O'Connor Reserve to secure the area and prevent public access.

Noise and dust control measures will be implemented to reduce the impact on the local community. Traffic management and excavation signage will be in place while these works are in progress.

Access to nearby properties will be maintained throughout these works.

Working hours

The NSW Government has recently passed legislation to allow construction hours to be extended outside of those specified in the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act (1979) under the COVID-19 Development-Construction Work Days Order (No3) 2021 to protect the health, safety and welfare of construction workers and our community during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The construction hours are 7 am to 5 pm Monday to Friday, 7 am to 5 pm Saturday and 9 am to 5 pm Sunday.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently, and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.
