
I'd like to thank our community – students, staff, parents and local residents – for their patience during construction. I am sure you'll be as pleased as we are with the outcome.



## What to expect


Students will transition into their new learning hub from Day 1 Term 1 2020. The floor plans show the classroom allocation for 2020. Week 1 classroom allocations will be flexible.

School administration has been relocated to demountable office buildings near the Keeler Street entrance (refer to site map below). This will allow the existing administration building to close for refurbishment works which should be completed by Term 2 2020.

## Frequently asked questions

### What is being delivered at Carlingford Public School?

The new three-storey building with 20 new flexible learning spaces, a hall, flexible library space and landscaping improvements are completed. This exciting project will also deliver upgrades to core facilities including staff and administration areas.

### When will the school move into the new facilities?

The new classrooms and hall will be ready to use from Day 1 Term 1 2020. Out of School Hours Care (OSHC) will remain in the current temporary location and move into the new building in the future.

### Will there be any changes to school entrances, street parking, staff parking or the bus stop?

No, these remain unchanged and will continue to operate as usual. Students will continue to use the two entrances on Rickard Street and Keeler Street. Please see the map for more information.

### What works are being undertaken during Term 1 2020?

For Term 1 2020 works will continue to refurbish the heritage administration and staff building.

### When will the project be completed?

We anticipate the Carlingford Public School upgrade will be completed by Term 2 2020.
