Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is spending \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. This includes an additional \$160 million in 2018/19 as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the biggest investment in public school infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Carlingford Public School project

A project is underway to upgrade Carlingford Public School. The project will deliver

- 20 new permanent teaching spaces
- a new hall
- an upgrade to some core facilities, including staff areas, administration and the library.

Project summary

The development application has been approved and the construction contract has been awarded.

Site establishment starts 2 October 2018

The contractor Grindley Construction will set up the site in the north-east corner of the school and remove the existing tennis court to provide space for the new building. The work will continue during the school term. Construction will be planned with the school to ensure disruption is minimal. Once complete the existing demountables on site will be removed and work undertaken to upgrade the existing admin building

Site establishment and construction will take place from 7am to 5pm Monday to Friday and 8am-5pm Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts at every opportunity.
