

# Carlingford West Public School and Cumberland High School

Works notification | 7 December 2023

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to upgrade Carlingford West Public School and Cumberland High School.

## Delivery of oversize mobile crane

From 1am to 4am on Thursday 7 December a 450 tonne mobile crane was delivered to Cumberland High School via Dunmore Avenue,

As the crane is an oversized vehicle, it must be delivered during these hours in compliance with road traffic regulations.

The mobile crane proceeded onto the school grounds, through the existing construction site and over to the far side of the oval near the basketball courts. No works occurred between 4am and 7am.

Work to set up the crane started at 7am on Thursday 7 December.

The crane is at the school to lift more temporary demountable classrooms into place along the western boundary with Sandringham Drive. This is to meet the needs of a growing school population at Cumberland High School. These student accommodation works are not part of the Carlingford West Public School and Cumberland High School schools' upgrade.

The crane is scheduled to leave the school between the same hours (1am to 4am) on Friday 8 December or Saturday 9 December depending on the weather.
