Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$8.9 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

The upgrade at Carlingford West Public School (CWPS) will deliver new modern classrooms, a new hall and library, new multipurpose play court, a new canteen, and refurbished staff and administration areas.

The upgrade to Cumberland High School (CHS) will deliver new modern classrooms including specialist spaces such as wood workshops and visual arts spaces, a new multipurpose hall, sport and performance spaces, new library, new multipurpose play courts, a new canteen, and refurbished staff and administration areas.

Progress update

Work on the CWPS & CHS upgrade is progressing. All piling works are now finished, and the following construction activities are underway:

- Concrete pours are continuing for the permanent concrete structure.
- High voltage power supply works on Dunmore Avenue to deliver power to the new buildings.

Next steps

- Continuing concrete pours, including ground slabs, columns and suspended floor slabs.
- Continuing to install underground pipes and cables.
- Upgrading the electricity supply, including new substations at both schools.
- Finishing the remaining excavation for the new buildings at both schools.
- Ongoing consultation and planning for new bus link road at CHS.
