As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to upgrade Carlingford West Public School and Cumberland High School.

Delivery of oversize piling rig to Dunmore Avenue - change of date

Due to the recent heavy rain in Sydney, the large 80 tonne piling rig for Cumberland High School, previously scheduled between 13 to 29 February 2024, is now being delivered between 11 and 31 March between 11pm and 5am via Dunmore Avenue.

This delivery is dependent on weather conditions and approval from Transport for NSW.

This piling rig will arrive via oversized vehicles and needs to be delivered overnight to comply with road traffic regulations. The oversized vehicles will travel slowly through residential streets before proceeding onto the sites. Rig delivery takes approximately one hour and the team will work to minimise noise as much as possible.

It will be delivered onto the school grounds and into the existing construction site behind timber hoarding fences.

This rig drills holes at depths of up to 12 metres to allow concrete placement for structural columns in the ground, to establish foundations for new buildings.

The piling rig for Carlingford West Public School via Felton Road (west) was delivered as planned on Thursday 15 February 2024.

The piling rigs will remain on site for a few months and another notification will be distributed for the removal of the piling rigs upon completion of the piling works.
