As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to upgrade Carlingford West Public School and Cumberland High School.

Removal of oversize piling rig

One evening between Tuesday 2 April 2024 and Friday 12 April 2024 between 11pm and 5am, a large 80 tonne piling rig is being removed from Carlingford West Public School via Felton Road west. This is dependent on weather conditions and approval from Transport for NSW.

This piling rig will be removed with oversized vehicles that need to access the site during the evening and early hours of the morning to comply with Transport for NSW's and Council's road traffic regulations.

The oversized vehicles will travel slowly through residential streets. It will take approximately one hour to leave the site and the team will work to minimise noise as much as possible such as turning off engines while waiting to enter the site.

The rig is being removed to allow for asbestos remediation on the construction site at the Carlingford West Public School, as per our previous notification distributed on 11 March 2024. The piling rig at the high school will be relocated to the public school in late April or early May to continue with the piling work. A further notification will be issued to residents before the rig is relocated.
