As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to upgrade Carlingford West Public School and Cumberland High School.

Removal of oversize piling rig

We will be undertaking out of hours work to remove a large 80 tonne piling rig from Cumberland High School on one night between Thursday 30 May 2024 and Friday 7 June 2024.

The rig will be removed via Dunmore Avenue between 11 pm and 5 am and taken directly to Carlingford West Public School via Felton Road west, if approval is granted by Transport for NSW (TfNSW) and weather conditions allow. If this is not possible, the rig will be removed and then delivered to the public school on another night before Friday 7 June 2024.

The piling rig will be removed with oversized vehicles that need to access the site late at night and during the early hours of the morning to comply with Transport for NSW's and Council's road traffic regulations.

All oversized and out of hours vehicle movements are dependent on weather conditions and approval from Transport for NSW.

The oversized vehicles will travel slowly through residential streets. It will take approximately one hour to leave the site and the team will work to minimise noise as much as possible such as turning off engines while waiting to enter the site.

Piling work will continue until July 2024.
