A project is underway to upgrade Carlingford West Public School and Cumberland High School.

Use of vibratory roller on link road

As part of the works to construct the carpark and link road between Dunmore Avenue and Blenheim Road a vibratory roller will be used on site on Monday 12 December, Tuesday 13 December and Friday 16 December 2022.

Vibration levels will be monitored in accordance with the site-specific Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan. To ensure vibration levels are maintained within the limits, three vibration monitors have been set up on neighbouring properties. These monitors ensure an accurate record of vibrations is kept and will send an alert if the vibrations exceed standard practice.

Managing construction impacts

The safety of the school's students, staff, visitors and the local community is our highest priority. Construction planning is designed so there is minimal impact on school operations. Safety measures will be in place to separate the construction site from areas occupied by the school and ensure students are unable to enter construction areas.

There is regular consultation with the school to discuss construction progress.
