A project is underway to upgrade Carlingford West Public School and Cumberland High School.

State Significant Development application on exhibition until 5 December 2022

Further to our recent Project Update – November 2022, the State Significant Development (SSD) application has now been lodged with the NSW Department of Planning and Environment (DPE). It will be on public exhibition by DPE until Monday 5 December 2022.

Project overview

The Department of Education has listened to the community's feedback and has developed a joint project to upgrade Carlingford West Public School and Cumberland High School.

The proposed upgrade at Carlingford West Public School includes the construction of four new buildings up to three storeys high, and is designed to deliver new flexible learning spaces, new hall, new library, new canteen, and refurbished staff and administration areas.

The proposed upgrade to Cumberland High School includes the construction of three new buildings up to five stories high, and is designed to deliver new flexible learning spaces including specialist spaces such as wood/metal workshops and visual arts spaces, new multipurpose hall, sport and performance spaces, new library, new canteen, and refurbished staff and administration facilities.

Next steps

DPE will review all submissions received during the 28-day public exhibition period. When public exhibition has ended, DPE will request School Infrastructure NSW provide a formal response to submissions, before completing the assessment of the application. The SSD approval process can take between six to nine months.
