

# Carlingford West Public School and Cumberland High School

Works notification | 19 January 2023

A project is underway to upgrade Carlingford West Public School and Cumberland High School.

## Asbestos remediated in Building F at Cumberland High School and demolition underway

As notified on 16 November 2022, as part of the upgrade to Cumberland High School works have been undertaken to remove asbestos containing materials from Building F prior to the building being demolished.

The works are being done in stages, and three of the four stages are now complete.

- **Stage 1: Preparation** began on 19 November 2022 and the building was cleared and prepared for asbestos removal.
- **Stage 2: Remediation of friable asbestos** was completed during the summer holidays and a clearance certificate was issued, prior to work beginning on Stage 3: Remediation of bonded asbestos.
- **Stage 3: Remediation of bonded asbestos** has been completed ahead of schedule and a clearance certificate was issued on Tuesday 10 January 2023.

Works have now moved into **Stage 4: Demolition of Building F**, to remove the remaining structure. These works are currently underway and will continue into early February 2023.

## Managing construction impacts

The safety of the school's students, staff, visitors and the local community is our highest priority. Construction planning is designed so there is minimal impact on school operations. Safety measures are in place to separate the construction site from areas occupied by the school and ensure students are unable to enter construction areas.

There is regular consultation with the school to discuss construction progress.
