Early investigation work taking place at Carlingford West Public School

We are planning an upgrade at Carlingford West Public School to support the growing student community.

From Monday 12 April to Wednesday 14 April, our crews will be conducting bore hole testing on the Carlingford West Public School site.

We expect we will need to drill 12 boreholes on the site, up to a maximum depth of six metres. We will use a truck-mounted drill rig to make these bore holes, which is roughly as loud as a commercial lawnmower. There will also be a small excavator on site and up to 10 crew members on site to conduct this work. The work will take up to two days to complete.

Our crews will be entering the site at the entry on Felton Road East. Test areas will be cordoned off during drilling to ensure public safety, and the holes will be filled once the testing is complete. There will be no traffic impacts as a result of this work.

Over the coming months, there will also be visits to the new site location by our project team and contractors such as architects and engineers who will be conducting a range of investigations as part of their early planning and design work.

Working hours

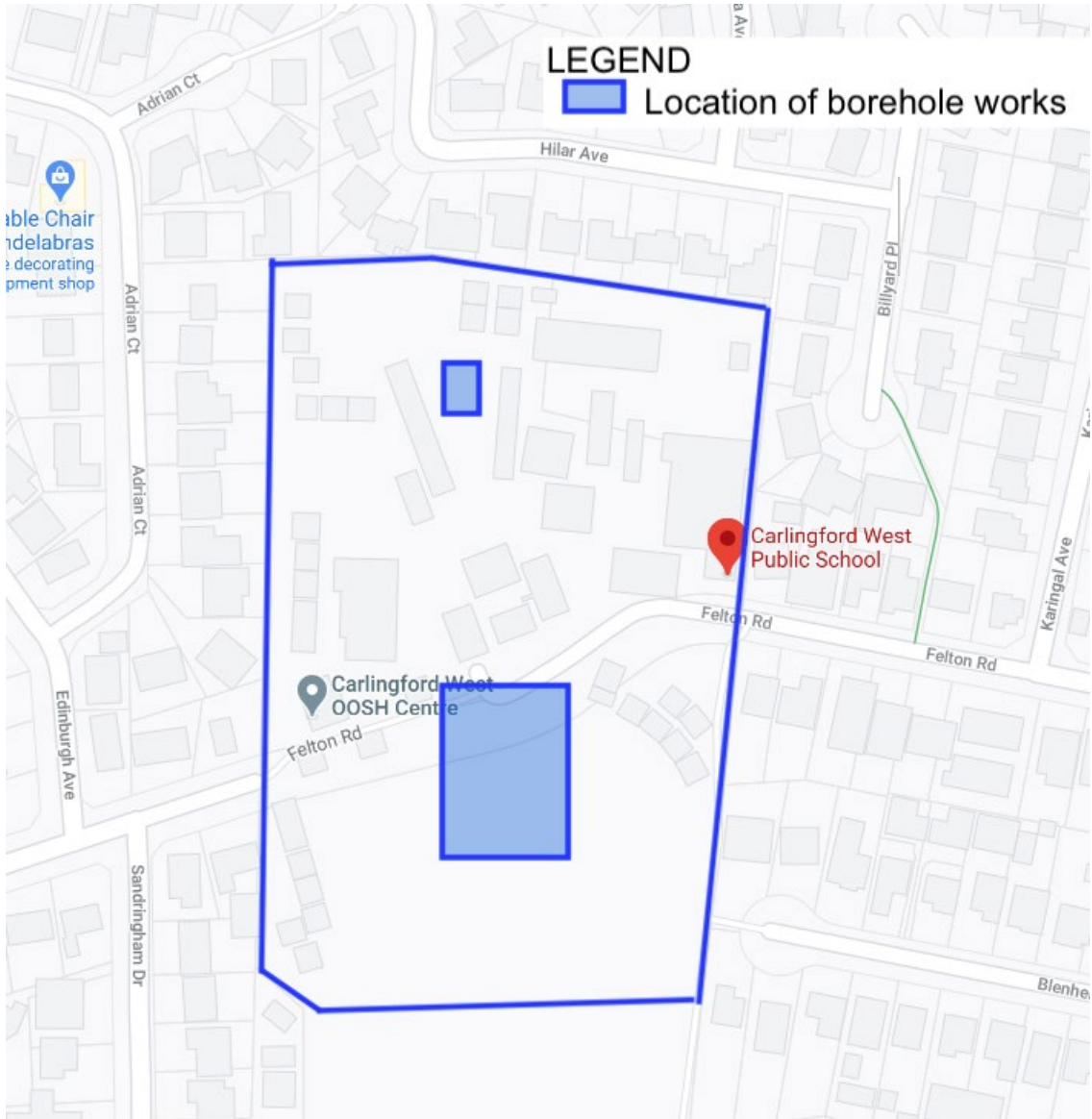
