Early investigation work taking place at Carlingford West Public School

We are planning an upgrade at Carlingford West Public School to support the growing student community.

On Saturday 1 May 2021, our crews will be conducting bore hole testing and installing ground water wells on the Carlingford West Public School site.

We expect we will need to drill 26 boreholes on the site, up to a maximum depth of three metres. We will use a hand auger to make these bore holes, which produces minimal noise. There will also be a small excavator on site and up to 4 crew members on site to conduct this work. The work is expected to take one day to complete.

Our crews will be entering the site at the entry on Felton Road East. Test areas will be cordoned off during drilling to ensure public safety, and the holes will be filled once the testing is complete ahead of the students returning to school on Monday.

There will be no traffic impacts as a result of this work.

Over the coming months, there will also be visits to the school site by our project team and contractors such as architects and engineers who will be conducting a range of investigations as part of their early planning and design work.

Working hours and location

Our working hours for Saturday 1 May will be 8:00am to 1:00pm.

No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.


