

Cecil Hills High School

School holiday works notification | 5 April 2023

A project to upgrade Cecil Hills High School is underway and will provide additional permanent learning spaces and core facilities to support the growing population in Western Sydney.

During the upcoming April school holiday period we will move some of the school's temporary demountable classrooms and conduct soil investigations.

Moving demountable classrooms

Between Wednesday 12 April and Thursday 13 April 2023, the contractor will bring a mobile crane onto the school site to safely lift the demountables and move one to the northern side of the site, along Frederick Road, and one next to the football field.

Soil investigations

Soil investigations will involve using a large vehicle-mounted drill to drill holes in the ground to collect samples for testing. The samples will provide us with information on the physical properties of the soil and rock on the site to help plan for the upgrade.

The contractor will bring the drill onto the school site on Wednesday 19 April 2023 and remove it on Thursday 20 April.

Site access

The mobile crane, drill, and construction vehicles, will access the school site via the school entrance on Spencer Road. Traffic control will be in place to ensure the safety of the community.

Working Hours

We will undertake all work during the standard construction work hours of 7 am to 6 pm, Monday to Friday and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

Some deliveries to the site may need to take place outside of normal work hours because of the size of the trucks required. This is to minimise the impact on road users and the general public.

We will work to ensure that all works are carried out safely and efficiently and will minimise impacts to the community at every opportunity.
