Cecil Hills High School

Project update | May 2023

Project overview

The upgrade of Cecil Hills High School will include additional permanent learning spaces and core facilities to support the growing population in Western Sydney.

The upgrade will deliver a new building with flexible learning spaces, including some with a STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) focus. The school's existing gym/hall will be extended and refurbished to create a multipurpose hall, the canteen will be extended, a new external work shop will be built, new staff facilities provided and improvements made to existing ramps and walkways.

Progress summary

We have received the complying development certificate (CDC) for the works to the existing gym/hall and we are waiting to receive the CDC for the new building and outdoor workshop.

The main works construction contract is now out for tender and we expect to confirm a building contractor by mid-2023.

Next steps

Once we have appointed a builder for the project, they will work on a detailed design for the upgrade and a timeline for construction.

The detailed design phase is the final phase of the design process. It involves working with the school to choose finishes, fittings and furniture for all spaces.
