## Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

## Project overview

The upgrade of Cecil Hills High School will deliver modern flexible classrooms, including some with a science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) focus. This includes the extension and refurbishment of the existing hall to create a multipurpose hall, extension of the canteen, new staff facilities, a new outdoor workshop, new covered walkways and accessibility improvements to existing ramps and walkways.

## Progress summary

Work on the Cecil Hills High School upgrade is progressing well. The extension and refurbishment of the hall and the extension of the canteen are complete, and these areas are in use by the school. Please see overleaf for photographs of the newly finished hall.

We have also upgraded and reopened the staff car park and landscaping near the hall.

## Next steps

Work taking place over the coming weeks and months on the new classroom building includes installing the external façade of the building, concrete pours for the building stairs and works on the new classrooms' interiors.

Public domain works will continue with the widening of the pedestrian footpath, installation of a new kiss and drop zone and a new wombat crossing to provide a safe crossing for the school community.
