

# Upgrade to Chatswood High School

## Works notification

July 2022

### Reinstatement of the perimeter fencing at Chatswood High School

Between 4 July and 16 July, boundary perimeter fencing for Chatswood High School will be reinstated along Eddy Road and De Villiers Avenue. The new perimeter will be palisade fencing, consisting of vertical steel pales secured to horizontal rails. This will replace the existing welded steel mesh fencing and is a more secure type of fencing.

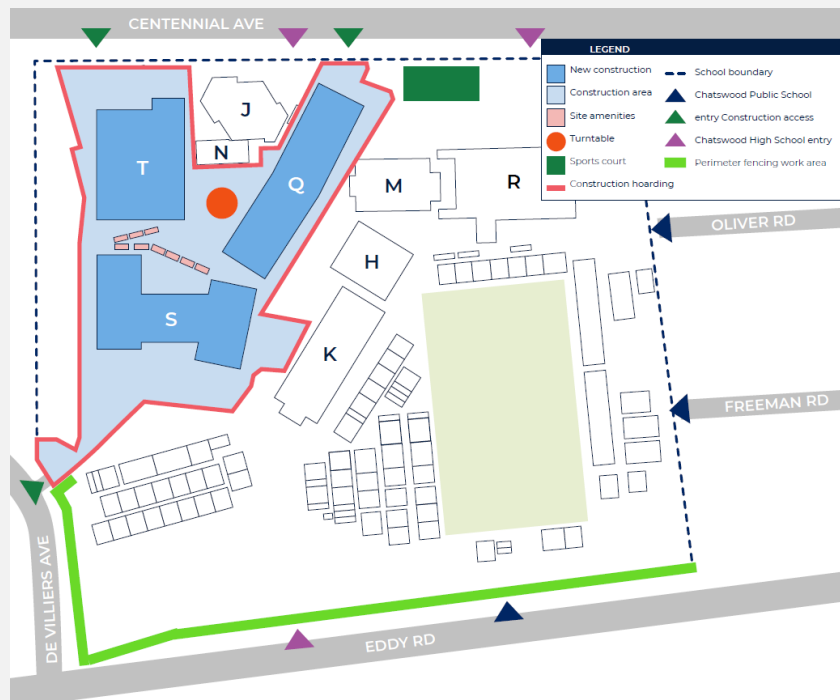
The works will take place within standard construction hours of Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm, Saturday 8am – 4pm, and will include:

- prior to the works, the contractor's arborists will provide advice on the biodiversity bushland vegetation to mitigate against any potential for adverse impacts
- marking of the fence line to identify the locations for the fence posts
- digging the footings for the post supports
- installation of the post supports
- attaching the fence panels to the post supports
- filling in footings as necessary.

Gates will be installed as part of a later sequence of work and will be notified separately.

Footpaths on Eddy Road and De Villiers Avenue will remain open to the public for the duration of the installation, and we do not expect the work to be noisy.
