Tower crane removal at Chatswood Public School

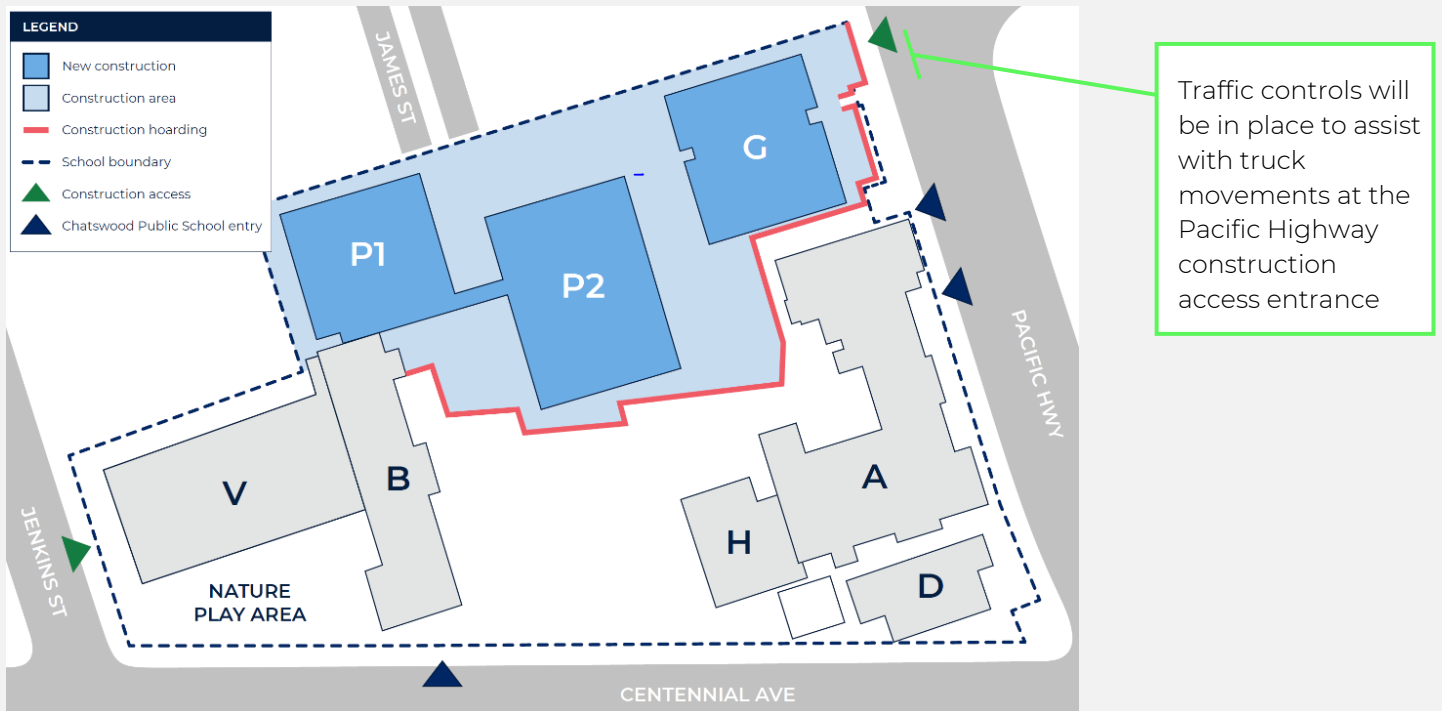
On Friday 7 October between 5:00am and 9:00pm, the tower crane at Chatswood Public School will be dismantled and removed from site, weather permitting. As a contingency, the dismantling and removal will take place on Saturday 8 October.

A mobile crane will assist to dismantle the tower crane into smaller components ready to be removed from site. All dismantling activity will occur within the confines of the construction site, and we do not expect the activity to be noisy. An oversized vehicle will deliver the mobile crane and collect the dismantled tower crane components through the Pacific Highway construction entrance as shown on the map below.

Whilst traffic control measures will be in place to assist vehicle movements to and from the site, there will be no road closures on the Pacific Highway.

The extended hours for this work have been approved by the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE). The extension of hours allows this work to be completed across a two-day period and allows for trucks to enter and exit the site during the school holidays to minimise disruption to traffic and to the community.
