Chatswood Public School and Chatswood High School Project update and works lookahead August 2022

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017. a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Chatswood High School

Building S has been a hive of activity throughout July. When finished, it will be home to learning spaces for the sciences, creative arts and performance and general learning across a five-storey footprint. July saw the continuation of work to build the lift and stair shafts and the brickwork and blockwork for the façade. Installation of roof steel also started and will continue through August. The music rooms on lower ground level now have windows and internal walls and services installation has been completed.

Foundations for Buildings Q and T are taking shape with work to install in-ground services finished in July.

Work has started for the pour of the concrete slab for Building T, an important milestone for the future school hall.

During the school holidays, a new palisade perimeter fence was installed at the boundary of the high school on Eddy Road and De Villiers Avenue. The new fence replaces the low height steel mesh fencing and is per approved SSD plans, and the department's design and security guidelines. New gas meters were also installed in the holidays.

Chatswood Public School

Work has started on the foundations for the new single-storey double height hall, Building G. The building will provide the new Pacific Highway pedestrian entrance for the school and outof-school hours care facilities (OOSHC).

Buildings P1 and P2 continue to progress well with lift installation now finished. Windows are installed throughout and roof steel is now installed in Building P2.

In Building P1, internally the wall sheeting is finished and work has started to build the joinery in rooms on level 1.

Preparations have started to remove the hoist ahead of the scaffolding being removed. The hoist has been an essential tool to move materials within the site.

During the school holidays, upgrades were undertaken to the air conditioning system in Building A and the communications network across the school.

Chatswood High School - next steps


Construction of the foundations for Buildings T and Q will continue into August, including the installation of in-ground services. The concrete slab for Building T will be poured as part of the foundation of the new school hall.

Building S will see a continuation of work to install services, lifts, and fixtures and fittings. Externally, work will continue on the brickwork façade and cladding, and the installation of roof steel.

Work to finalise the façade for Buildings P1 and P2 will progress in August followed by the removal of the scaffolding to reveal the new buildings. Internally, services installation will continue in addition to fixtures and fittings.

Building G foundations will continue to progress and the building of the external structure will start.



Access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times. Where temporary footpath changes, car parking removal or lane closures are required for works, traffic control, pedestrian detours, and signage will be in place to assist the community.

Some of this work may be noisy; however, we will take every possible step to minimise noise, such as switching off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Standard construction hours for this project are 7 am to 6 pm Mondays to Fridays, and 8 am to 4 pm, Saturdays. No works will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise notified.
