

Upgrades to Chatswood Public School and Chatswood High School

Works notification | 16 February 2023

We are upgrading Chatswood Public School and Chatswood High School with new and improved education facilities to support the student community.

Construction loading zone at the eastern end of Centennial Avenue – Chatswood Public School

Buildings P1 and P2 being ready for the Chatswood Public School students to use for Day 1 Term 1 2023 was a major milestone in the upgrade project’s timeline. Although the major buildings are complete, there is still ongoing construction at the school to build the new school hall, a new sports court and a yarning circle and landscaping in the central courtyard.

During the summer school holidays, a new construction zone was created in the central courtyard. Access to the new construction zone is through the corner of Centennial Avenue and Pacific Highway, and a strip of the road on Centennial Avenue has been kept as a ‘construction loading zone’. This is needed for the delivery and removal of equipment and materials to site. It is not possible for the workers to use the previous construction access at Jenkins Street as that access leads to the new operational part of the school.

The construction loading zone is in place between the projects approved State Significant Development hours of 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays (4pm for non-noisy works). Traffic management is in place to ensure the safety of pedestrian and vehicle traffic during the work, and to keep traffic moving through the area as efficiently as possible. The construction loading zone will be in place until mid-2023.

We appreciate the patience of the community, particularly around drop off and pick up times, as we work to finish the construction and remove the construction loading zone.
