Project update | June 2023

Progress summary and next steps

With new Buildings T, Q and G now handed over to the schools, we are at an exciting point in the Chatswood Schools upgrade project's timeline. To coincide with final landscaping works being finished, the public school is planning a welcome event to celebrate the new facilities in Term 3. Similarly, the high school will celebrate in Term 4.

This will be the final regular monthly update as the project team works to finalise the remaining landscaping at both schools and refurbishment works at the high school. The planned activity for the remainder of 2023 is provided for each school overleaf. We will continue to inform the community of any works which may be impactful with work notifications.

Management of construction impacts

During construction, access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times. Where temporary footpath changes, car parking removal or lane closures are required for works, traffic control, pedestrian detours, and signage will be in place to assist the community.

Some of this work may be noisy; however, we will take every possible step to minimise noise, such as switching off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Standard construction hours for this project are 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 4 pm, Saturdays. No works will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise notified.

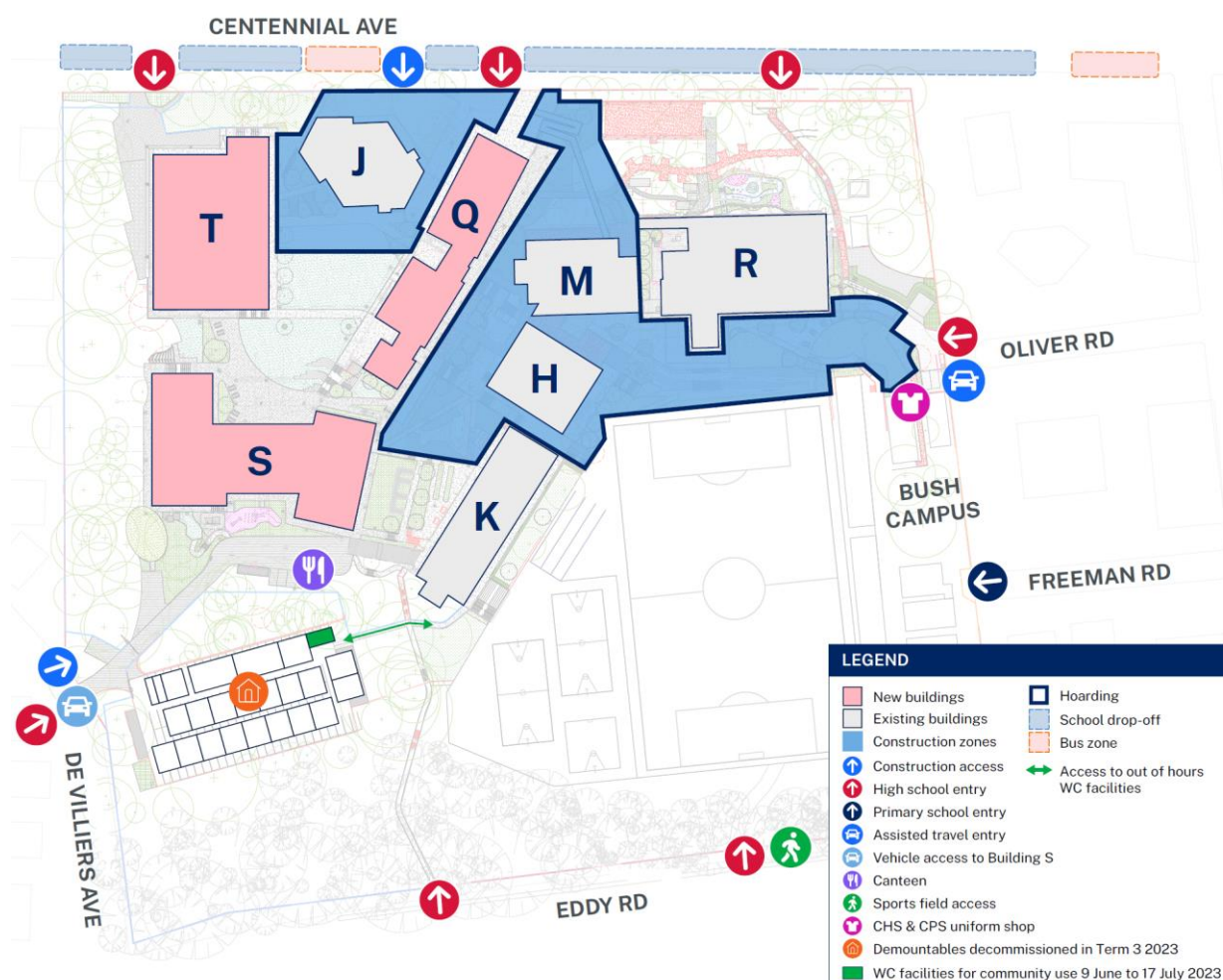
Between Friday 9 June and Monday 17 July 2023, Building H lower ground toilets and change rooms will not be available for use by community members accessing the outdoor sports facilities at the high school. Two female and two male toilets will be available in the temporary demountables as marked on the map on page 2. During this time there will be no standalone changeroom facilities.

Indicative map of the Chatswood High School work zone

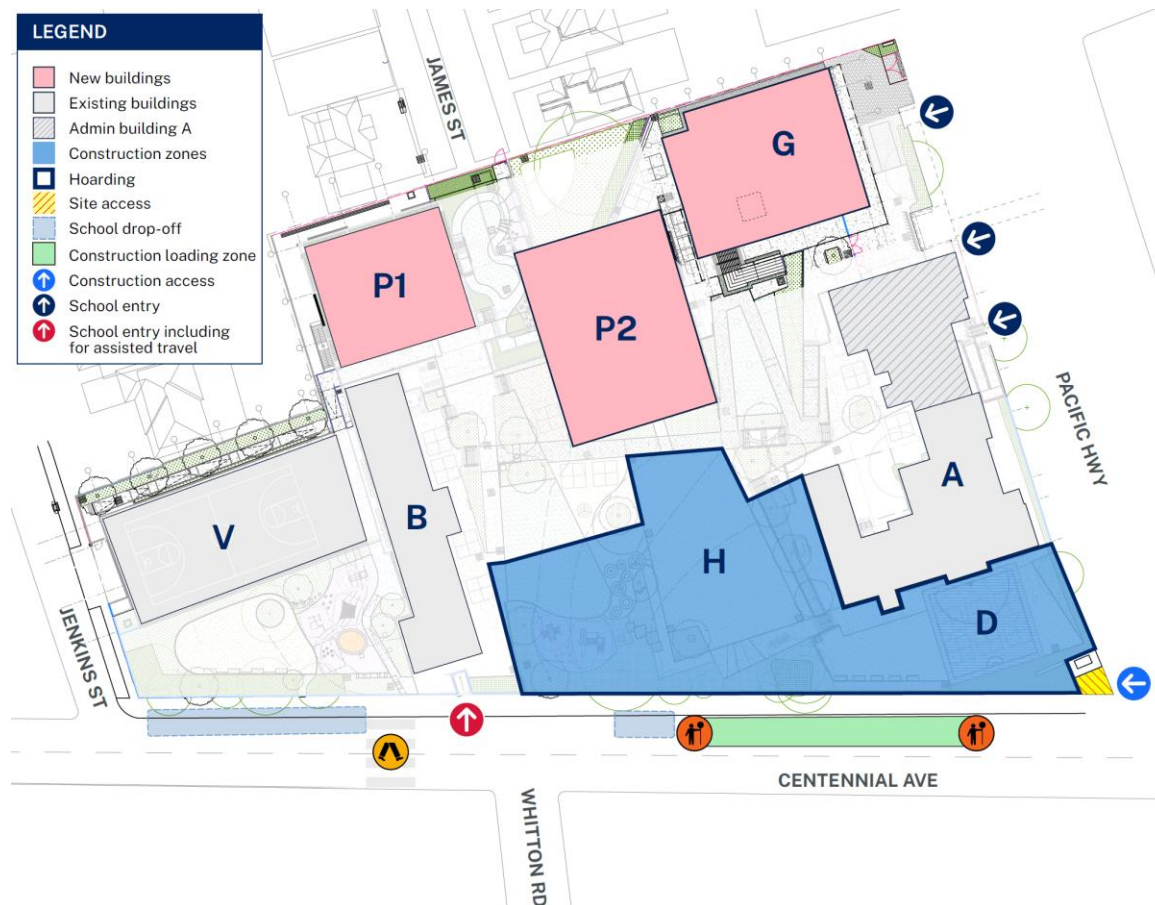

<i>June to July 2023</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handing over the staff car park in Building V on Jenkins Street. • Handing over the new sports court, yarning circle and newly landscaped central courtyard • Completion of stormwater works on Jenkins Street • Installation of new retaining walls on Jenkins Street, Centennial Avenue and Pacific Highway • Rectification of retaining wall along the northern boundary with neighbours on James Street and Jenkins Street (subject to approval) • Removal of construction loading zone and access on corner of Centennial Avenue and Pacific Highway • Removal of hoarding • Packing down site accommodation and services.

Chatswood Public School – The new school hall (Building G)

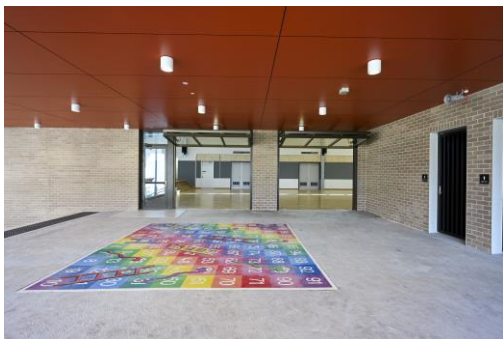
The new school hall is a single storey building with a built-in stage with curtains, and a full audio-visual setup including a lighting rig and projector screen. The beautiful hardwood flooring is the star of the space which will be used for sport activities, school assembly's, hosting school plays and music recitals and will be the future home of OOSHC.

Custom built full height doors look out over the public-school central courtyard and can be fully opened to create an undercover gathering and entry to the space. These full height doors lead to a covered outdoor learning area with a bright and fun snakes and ladders for the students (and staff!) to enjoy!

Support rooms include a large kitchenette and storage spaces to house foldaway seating and sports equipment. The front of the building is the new main public school entry point from Pacific Highway and includes bicycle parking and new school gates.

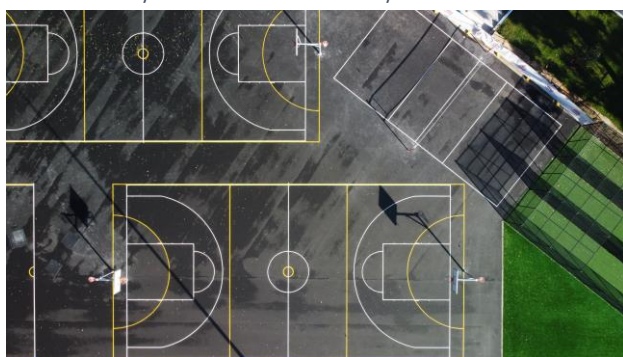
