Upgrades to Chatswood Public School and Chatswood High School

The NSW Government is upgrading Chatswood Public School and Chatswood High School with new and improved education facilities to support the student community.

Tree removal at Chatswood High School

A tree is scheduled to be removed near the north-west corner of the sports field by an independent tree specialist.

The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment has approved the removal of this tree as part of the State Significant Development application. The tree is being removed to allow an accessible ramp to be installed in the north-west corner of the sports field and in preparation for the main works construction starting.

An arborist has identified the tree as an Acacia species. The common name for the tree is Hickory Wattle. See the location of the tree below. Replacement planting will be carried out as the project progresses, in accordance with the relevant policy and in consultation with Willoughby Council.

The work will start on Saturday 27 March and is expected to take one to two days to complete. Work hours will be Monday to Friday, 7:00am and 6:00pm and Saturday, 8:00am to 1:00pm. in line with the current NSW Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development – Construction Work Days Order 2020). This is to allow workers to abide by social distancing rules during the COVID-19 pandemic by distributing work across the week. There will be no work on Sundays or Public Holidays without prior notification.
