

Chatswood Public School

Works notification

16 August 2021

During initial earthworks as part of the upgrade of Chatswood Public School, asbestos containing material has been identified in two stockpiles of excavated spoil within the construction site.

Safety measures and monitoring have been put in place to ensure there is no risk to students, staff, the local community or workers. The material is located within the secure construction site and is not accessible by students, staff or the local community.

The materials will be removed on Tuesday 17 August 2021 in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and SafeWork NSW regulations. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

Testing will be completed to ensure the area has been fully remediated. The school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is open to students and staff.

The health, safety, and well-being of the school and the local community is our highest priority and we will continue to keep the community updated.
