

Upgrades to Chatswood Public School and Chatswood High School

The NSW Government is upgrading Chatswood Public School and Chatswood High School with new and improved education facilities to support the student community.

Upcoming works

The demountable installation works are progressing at Chatswood High School.

To allow the works to proceed on the basketball court and near the car park, Willoughby Council has approved an application for the pruning of two native trees and the removal of one weed.

An arborist has identified the two native trees as a Sydney Blue Gum and a Sydney Red Gum and the weed as a Large-leaf Privet. See map overleaf.

These works will be carried out before Christmas by an independent tree specialist.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.

Thank you for your patience while we deliver this important school infrastructure.

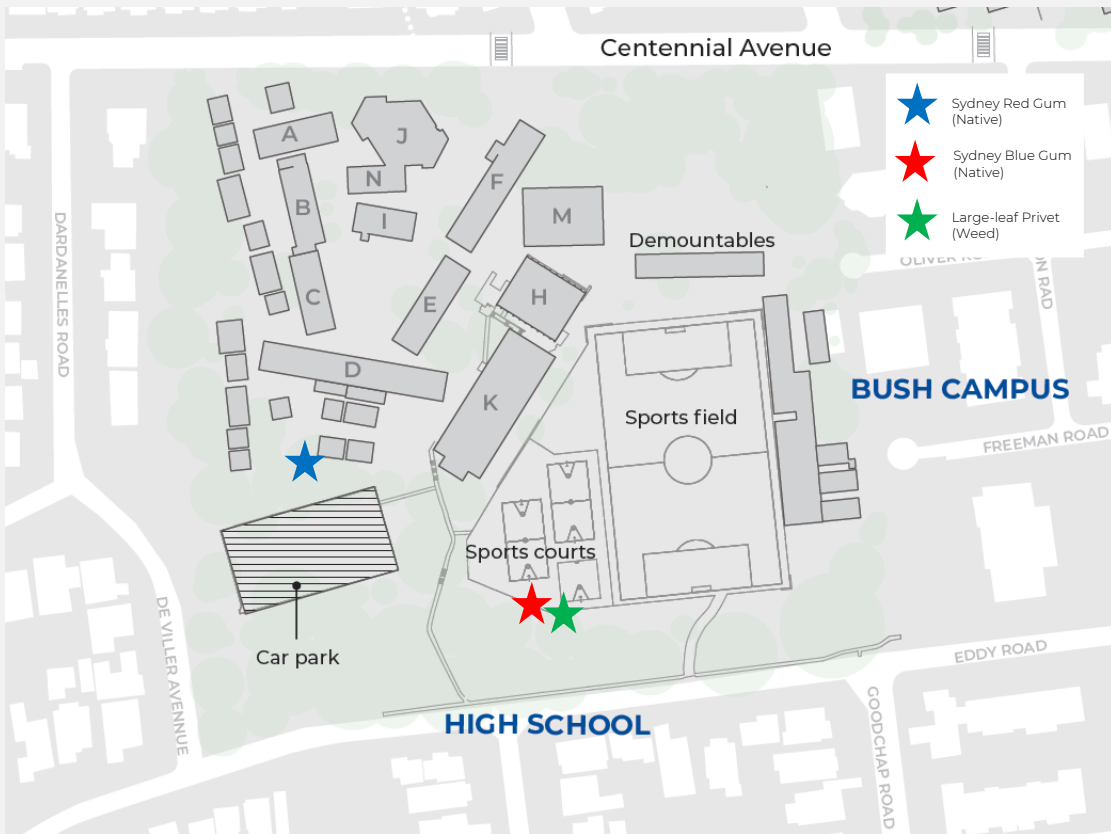
