

Upgrades to Chatswood Public School

Dear Community,

We are upgrading Chatswood Public School and Chatswood High School with new and improved education facilities to support the student community.

Tower crane installation at Chatswood Public School

On Friday 8 October between 7:00am and 6:00pm and Saturday 9 October between 7:00am and 5:00pm, a tower crane will be installed at Chatswood Public School within the current hoarding and construction site, weather permitting (see map). In the event of rain, the installation will take place on Monday 11 October and Tuesday 12 October between 7:00am and 6:00pm.

The tower crane will assist with the movement of materials on site.

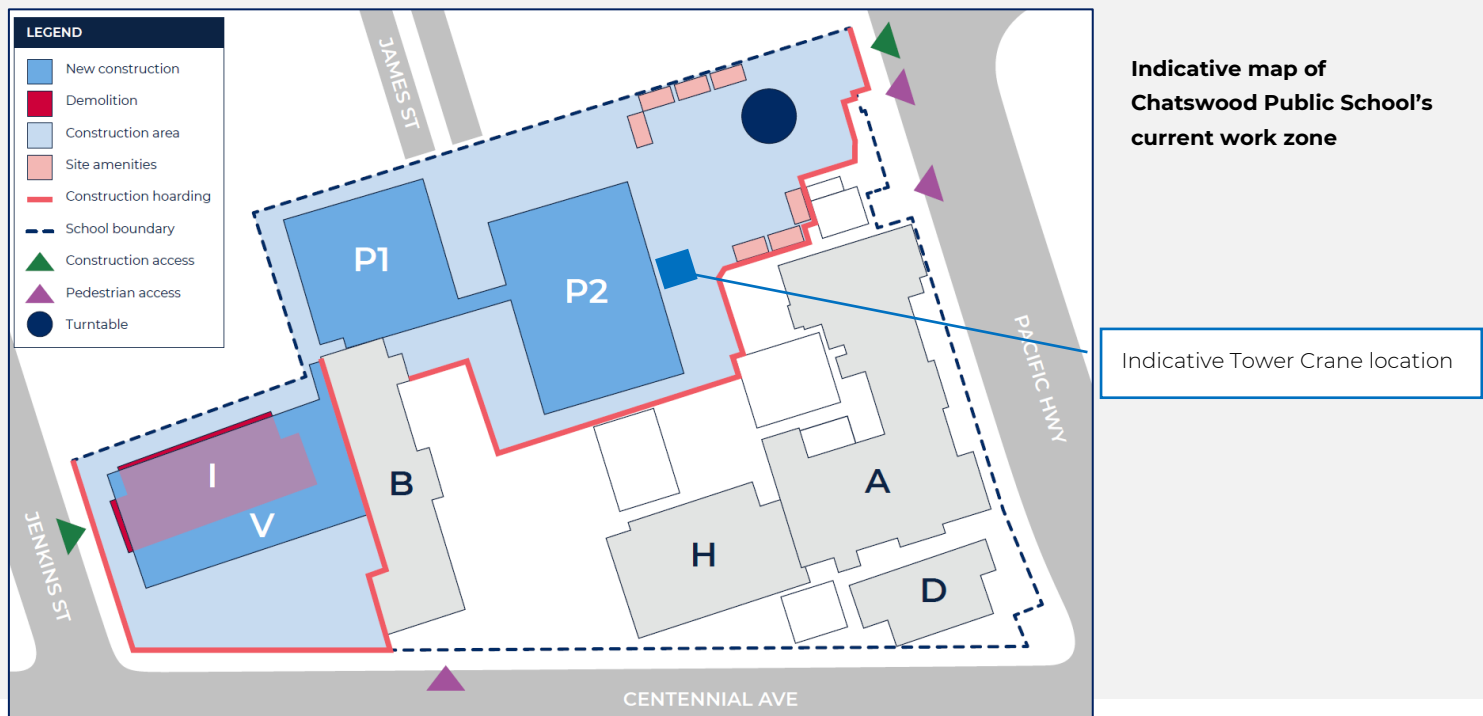
An oversized vehicle will deliver the tower crane through the Pacific Highway vehicle entrance and traffic control will be in place.

Appropriate controls and monitoring measures will operate while the crane is on site. Crane loads are restricted to lifting within the perimeter of the construction site only.

When not in use the crane will operate in 'free slew', which is a safety measure that allows it to move freely in the wind when not in use. The crane installation will be signed off by a Structural Engineer ahead of being used for construction and movement of materials, and will also be subject to daily pre-start inspections prior to operation.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts to the community at every opportunity.

Thank you for your patience while we deliver this important school infrastructure.
