Chatswood Public School and Chatswood High School Works notification September 2021

Dear Community,

We are upgrading Chatswood Public School and Chatswood High School with new and improved education facilities to support the student community.

Temporary classroom installation works

Temporary classrooms will be installed at Chatswood High School to accommodate enrolment growth and enable the next stage of construction.

The temporary classrooms will be installed on the existing sports court and around Building R prior to Day 1 Term 1 2022.

The installation work on the existing sports court will start from 20 September 2021 and is expected to be completed by early November 2021, weather and site conditions permitting.

Cranes and large vehicles will access the site through the Oliver Road and Eddy Road vehicle entrances.

Temporary fenced areas at Chatswood High School

Temporary fencing will be installed around work areas to allow the work to continue safely and efficiently (see map overleaf). This includes the installation of temporary fencing on a section of the oval and around Building R.

We have engaged Polytan, the company which installed the oval's artificial surface, to provide appropriate protective measures for the section of oval that will be fenced off.

The fencing and oval protective measures are expected to be removed in early November 2021, once the demountable installation work is complete.

Access changes

The existing stairs and pathway from Centennial Avenue to the Bush Campus and oval will be closed until the opening of Building R in late January 2022 (see map).

Public School students can access the Bush Campus from Freeman Road and Eddy Road. Further information will be provided about pick-up and drop-off procedures before public school students return on 25 October 2021.

Community access to the High School oval has been redirected to Eddy Road. Community access via Oliver Road adjacent to the construction entry will also be available from 27th September 2021.

The Eddy Road entry will also be used for construction deliveries until mid-November 2021. Traffic management will be in place during deliveries to ensure the safety of students and the community.

We are working closely with both school principals to minimise disruption to students and staff and are continuing to liaise with Willoughby Council as the coordinator of community sporting groups.
